## Cambodia Report

Nov. 1-7, 2012 Phnom Penh



When we arrive at the conference, there are 95 women there. By the end of the morning, we have 118 women and every day we gain a few more in numbers. Eager to learn, the women crowd into a room meant for half as many people. We teach on marriage, God's provision, daily devotions, the wordless book and personal hygiene. And that is just Day One!

Over lunch I have the opportunity to visit with Joko, a missionary to Cambodia from Indonesia. Over and over again he reiterates how much this Cambodia generation needs training and teaching such as our team is providing. Joko has been working in Cambodia for 9 years. The median age in Cambodia is only 23. The generations who would be the present day leaders and mentors are gone – victims of the Khmer Rouge regime led by Pol Pat, who murdered 1.7 million people from 1975-1979. The present-day leaders of the church in Cambodia may be young but they are committed to Jesus and to spreading the Gospel in Cambodia. They want to learn how to be Godly leaders.

The following 2 days included teaching on the value of life, women's health issues, teaching children, developing lessons to teach, covenants, forgiveness and more. Here are some comments by the women:

- ☞ "Thank you for helping me understand how God sees life and for giving me the baby [12 week fetal form]. Now I can show others that abortion is wrong."
- ☞ "I learned there are many ways to teach children and get them interested in learning."
- ☞ "Thank you for teaching us how to use the book without words. Now I can tell others."

## Cambodia & Sex Trafficking

I had a sobering and sad first-hand glimpse at the sex trafficking business in Cambodia. There are 10,000 to 20,000 women and children prostituted in Phnom Penh, a city of 1 million. In 1993, the average age of a prostituted person was 15 and (even worse) the average age is declining. These enslaved girls are either abducted or sold to traffickers who often smuggle them into other countries. The statistics are staggering; seeing it in person is sickening; there is a sense of sorrow (how can 1 person make a difference?); ~ **BUT GOD...is their HOPE.** **BUT GOD** who is rich in mercy (Eph. 2:4); **BUT GOD** who comforts the downcast (2 Cor. 7:6); **BUT GOD** is the builder of everything (Heb. 3:4); **BUT GOD** raised Jesus from the dead (Acts 3:15). The abused and enslaved need our prayers.
