## NORTHWEST COMMUNITY CHURCH MEMBERSHIP COMMITMENT

I am willing to make the following commitment to the Lord:

Having submitted my life to Jesus Christ as my Savior, I promise to forsake the ways of sin and to walk in Christian love and in the paths of righteousness by the aid of the Holy Spirit. I also purpose to maintain family and personal devotions, to teach the Bible to my children, to seek the salvation of my family and acquaintances, and to live a godly life in Christ.

I will endeavor to be a Christian example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, and in purity of life, remembering that "God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline" (2 Timothy 1:7), and that we are "the salt of the earth... [and] the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden" (Matthew 5:13-14).

I further purpose to give and receive admonition with gentleness and love; to remember each other in prayer; to aid each other in case of sickness and distress; to cultivate sensitivity of spirit and courtesy in speech; to be slow to take offense but always ready for reconciliation and, mindful of the Scriptures, to seek it without delay; and to encourage one another in the blessed hope of our Lord's return.

I realize that it is by God's grace and power that I am able to carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of the Word of God.
